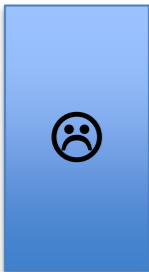

- Include other people in activities

Your job is to:

- Follow school and safety rules
- Help others to be safe
- Solve problems in a peaceful way
- Follow directions of school staff
- Report incidents of bullying

Your job is to:

- Respect other people's property
- Respect others' rights to privacy

Your job is to:

- Clean up after yourself
- Reduce, reuse, recycle
- Treat Maple Bay School and grounds with care

Helpful Hints:

CONSEQUENCES

It is the basic right of each student to obtain a quality education in a safe, positive and caring environment and no one has the right to disrupt this process.

Should the Code of Conduct not be followed, one or more of the following consequences will be applied. Consequences will be based on the type and frequency of the misbehaviour. Age and special needs will be taken into consideration.

*Note: examples only and not an all-inclusive list

- Parent Contact: phone, letter, meeting
- Referral to counselor
- Possible replacement or repair of damaged property
- Writing about the incident (Think Sheet)
- Time-out
- Referral to Principal or Teacher-in-Charge
- Walking with supervisor
- Loss of privileges - some examples may include loss of playground time, computer, Centres
- Restricted school hours or work/play areas
- Suspension
- Actions directed by District Policy
- Some students will go onto an Individual Education Plan

At Maple Bay School the following behaviours will not be tolerated:

- Disrespect to Staff
- Physical abuse / verbal abuse
- Intimidation/Retaliation/Bullying* (for more information, go to websites listed below)
- Possession or use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco or weapons
